Our Community

Waushara Community Church is located in Wautoma, Wisconsin, the county seat of Waushara County.

Located in Central Wisconsin, Waushara County is home to over 160 lakes, 108 miles of trout streams and 14 county parks within its 628.12 sq. miles.

The population of Waushara County as of 2021 was 24,555, of which 2,229 reside in Wautoma.

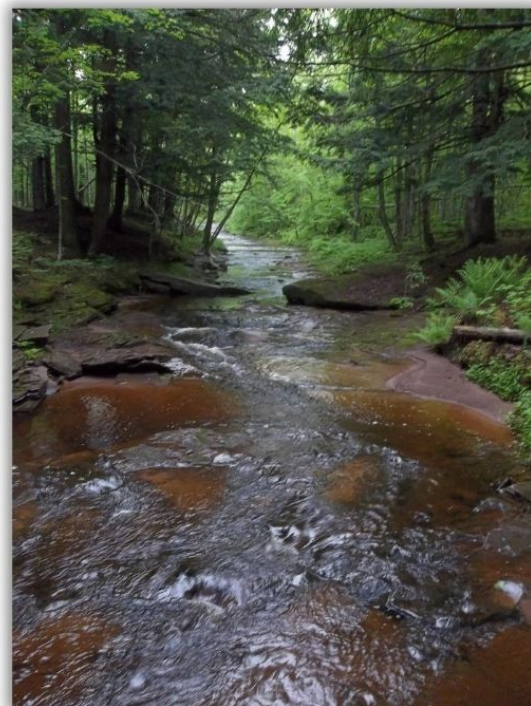
There are three school districts located in Waushara County. The Wautoma School District is the largest of the three school districts. It is located in east central Waushara County. Currently the Wautoma Area School District's 4K-12 enrollment is about 1,385. The Tri-County School District is the home to over 600 students attending the 4k-12th grade building. The Wild Rose School District serves approximately 600 students, housed in the elementary and middle/high school buildings.



Tourism is an important part of the local economy. Waushara is truly a county for all seasons. Fishing is a year-round activity, and hiking and biking trails abound. Water and downhill skiing and much more is offered in our very family friendly community. Our rural and scenic roads offer picturesque beauty and many vistas of this pastoral and lovely portion of God's creation.



This area, which lies almost completely in the path of the Central Plains, has prime land for agriculture and livestock. Once proclaimed "The Christmas Tree Capital of the World," locally we continue to lay claim to that title.



From supper clubs to small town shops: from the County Fair to locally sponsored races and other festivals, there is always something to do in this community that thrives on family, friends and fun.



Our Church

In May of 1988, a group of six families, desiring to have the Word of God affirmed and accurately taught, prayerfully discussed the feasibility of planting an Evangelical Free Church in the Wautoma area. With guidance and help from the Evangelical Free Church of America, services began at the Wautoma Senior Center.

The following year, the church family grew spiritually through study and prayer and began the candidacy process for pastors. In January, 1990, R. Alan Spitler accepted the call of Senior Pastor of WCC. Pastor Al served faithfully as pastor for 32 years. Shortly after his retirement, Pastor Adam Wolfgang came onboard as our interim pastor.

Over the years, the church location changed several times. In October 1992 a former Honda dealership building became the permanent home of WCC, making us locally known as 'The Honda Church'.

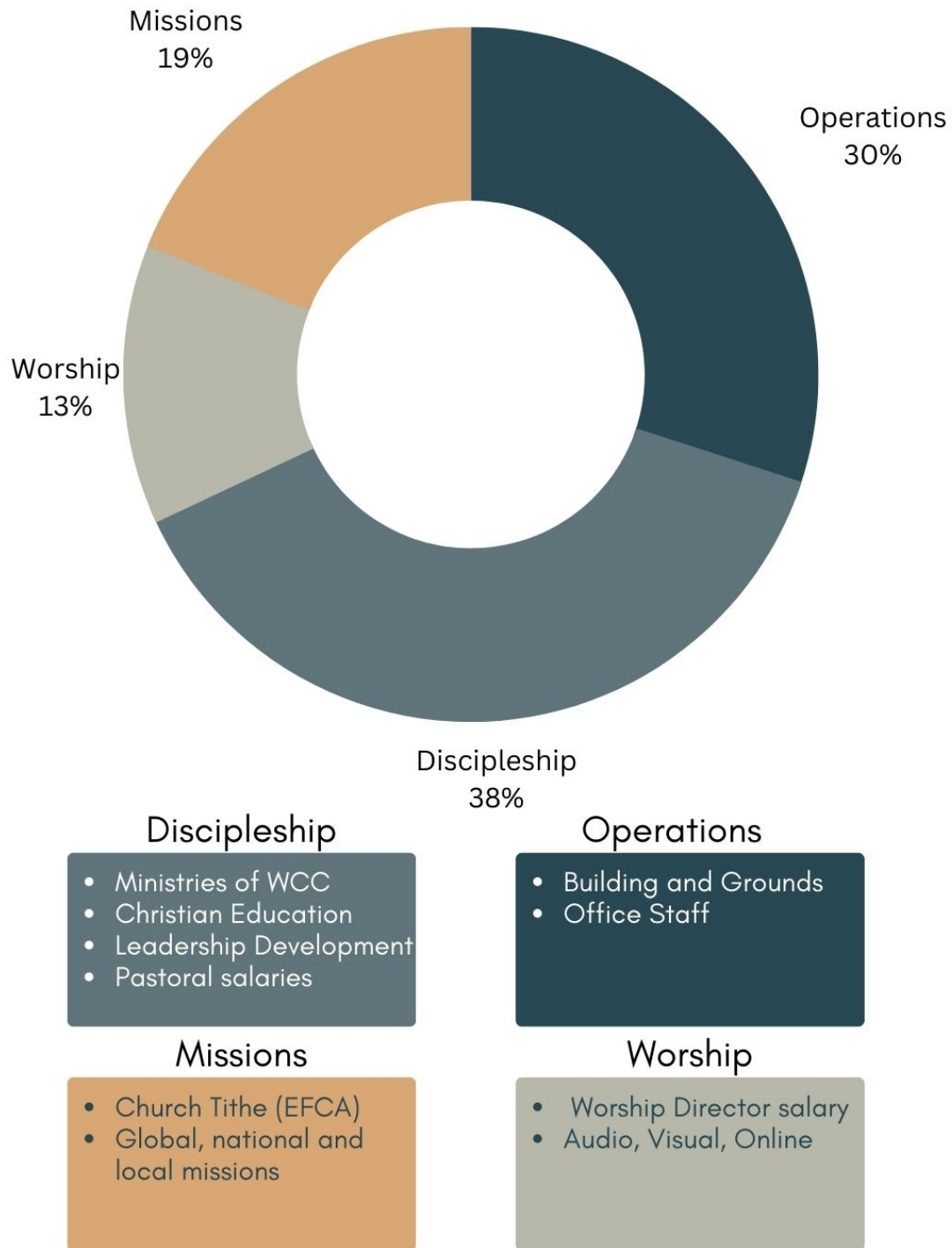
It is the mission of Waushara Community Church to build disciples in our community and beyond, proclaiming the message that Jesus Christ is Lord.
